Scholarship Application Process:

- 1. Submit FAFSA to ASU Financial Aid in November December.
- 2. Apply to 2-3 summer programs in **December February**. Apply to a Capstone program before the fall or spring deadline.
- 3. Submit a Flagship scholarship application in **January**. Summer program students need to complete a separate expense form (on page 2-3) for each summer program they are applying to.
- 4. Apply to additional scholarships in **December February**, such as the Gilman, Boren, Confucius Institute, Huayu Enrichment, etc.
- 5. Notify ASU Flagship staff on which summer programs you are accepted to and make your final decision for the summer by **March**.
- 6. Flagship scholarship notification letters will be distributed in **April**, and approved funds will be disbursed in **June July**.

According to the national guidelines set by The Language Flagship, students may be awarded <u>up to \$3,500</u> for domestic summer programs, <u>up to \$7,000</u> for overseas summer programs, and <u>up to \$15,000</u> for Capstone programs. These award amounts are contingent on available funding and may not be guaranteed every year. These guidelines do not apply to contracted ROTC cadets since they are eligible for full funding. All Flagship scholarships are merit-based and reflective of individual student performance and achievements in the ASU Chinese Language Flagship Program.

Contracted ROTC cadets may request full funding for program tuition and fees towards ASU and the host institution, room and board, books and supplies, food and meals, costs for host program excursions, airfare, checked luggage fee, local transportation, visa fees, insurance fees, and immunization fees. However, contracted ROTC cadets may not request funding for passport fees, non-program related excursions or travel, personal expenses, or dependent costs.
